## LESLIE'S HEALTHY EATING CORNER

### Breakfast : POTATOES OLE - Serves 4

1/4 cup chopped onion	1/2 cup evaporated milk
1/4 cup each chopped green red and yellow pepper	1/2 cup (2 ounces) shredded Monterey Jack Cheese
1 tbsp. butter	1/4 tsp salt
1 pound red potatoes, cooked, peeled and cubed (1/4 inch cubes)	Dash of pepper
1/2 can (2 ounces) chopped green chilies, drained	Salsa and Sour Cream Optional
3 eggs beaten	

- \* In a large skillet, sauté onion and peppers in butter until tender.
- \* Add potatoes and chilies: toss to combine
- \* Transfer to a greased 2 quart baking dish.
- \* In a large bowl, combine the eggs, milk, cheese, salt and pepper: pour over the potato mixture
- \* Bake, uncovered at 400 degrees for 35-40 minutes or until set and top is golden brown
- \* Serve with salsa and sour cream if desired

### Supper - CRANBERRY-APRICOT PORK TENDERLOIN - Serves 3-4 servings

1/2 cup dried cranberries	1/4 tsp salt (optional)
1/2 cup chopped dried apricots	Dash of pepper
1.5 tbsp. water	1 pork tenderloin 1/2 pound
1 tsp dried rosemary, crushed	

- \* In a saucepan, combine the cranberries, apricot, water, rosemary, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil.
- \* Reduce heat: cover and simmer for 10 minutes or until fruit is softened. Cool.
- \* Cut a lengthwise slit down the center of the tenderloin to within 1/2 inch of bottom
- \* Open tenderloin so they lie flat: cover with plastic wrap. Flatten to 3/4 inch thickness: remove plastic
- \* Spread fruit mixture to within 1/2 inch of ends.
- \* Close tenderloin: tie several times with kitchen string and secure with toothpicks
- \* Place on a rack in a shallow roasting pan.
- \* Sprinkle with salt and pepper if desired.
- \* bake, uncovered, at 400 degrees for 30-35 minutes or until a meat thermometer reads 160 degrees

### Side Dish - TWICE-AS-NICE MASHED POTATOES - Serves 3-4

1/2 large whole garlic bulb	1 tbsp. butter, softened
1 tbsp. olive oil	1/4 tsp dried rosemary crushed
3/4 pounds of red potatoes, peeled and cubed	1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese
3/4 pounds sweet potatoes, peeled and cubed	Salt and Pepper to taste
1/4 cup of milk	

- \* Remove papery outer skin from garlic (do not peel or separate cloves) Brush with oil. Wrap bulb in heavy-duty foil. Bake at 425 degrees for 30-35 minutes or until softened
- \* Cool for 10-15 minutes: peel garlic and reserve oil. Reduce heat to 400 degrees
- \* Place red and sweet potatoes in separate saucepans: cover with water. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat: cover and cook for 15-20 minutes or until very tender. Drain
- \* Place both potatoes in a large mixing bowl. Add the milk, butter, rosemary, roasted garlic, and reserved oil.
- \* Stir in Parmesan cheese, salt and pepper.
- \* Transfer to a greased baking dish. Cover and bake for 25-30 minutes or until heated through.
