LESLIE'S HEALTHY EATING CORNER

BREAKFAST - Italian Frittata - serves 4-5

3tbsp butter	3/4 cup chopped green onions
3/4 cup sliced mushrooms	6 eggs beaten
3 oz. of pepperoni or ham, or salami	3/4 cup grated mild cheddar cheese
pinch of white salt	3 tbsp milk. 1/4 cup oil
8 sauted button mushrooms, for garnish	

Saute onions and mushrooms in butter. To eggs add pepper, sauteed mixture, pepperoni, cheese and milk. Heat onion in pan. Add egg mixture and stir gently over medium high heat to cook evenly on the bottom. Cover, reduce heat to medium and allow to steam for 3-4 minutes to cook top. Slide onto serving tray and top with button mushrooms.

LUNCH - Tuna Casserole - serves 4-5

1 large bag of potato chips	1 tin of mushroom or cream of chicken soup
1 tin tuna fish - drained	1/2 cup milk
salt and pepper to taste	

Mix tuna, soup and milk together. Crush 3/4 of the bag of chips in your hand (not too small) and mix with the ingredients. Put into casserole and place remainder of the chips on top (do not crush these) but put them on top whole. Bake in the oven at 350 degrees for 20 minutes to a half an hour.

SUPPER -Pepper Steak - serves 4-6

4 cups round steak cubed in strips or boneless roast beef	
3 tbsp shortening	2 beef bouillon cubes
1 green or red pepper	3 tbsp cornstarch
2 1/2 cups water	2 tbsp soya sauce

Brown beef in shortening. Add 2 cups water and bouillon cubes. Simmer in a covered dish for one hour or until meat is tender. Add peppers cut in strips; simmer for 5 minutes. Blend cornstarch with soya sauce and 1/2 cup of water. Add to meat mixture stirring slowly until thickened. Serve over rice or pasta.
