LESLIE'S HEALTHY EATING CORNER

NOVEMBER IS ANOTHER COOL MONTH SOON TO PREPARE FOR OUR HOLIDAYS. NOTHING LIKE A WARM SOUP TO START OUR DAY

BUTTERNUT BISQUE - Serves 6

1 tsp butter	1 large onion coarsely chopped
1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg or freshly grated nutmeg	1/8 tsp pepper
1 medium butternut squash peeled, seeded and cut into 1/2 inch pieces	
2 cans (14 ozs each) reduced-sodium or regular chicken broth divided	

Melt butter in large saucepan over medium heat. Add onion; cook and stir 3 minutes. Add squash and 1 can chicken broth; bring to a boil over high heat. reduce heat to low; cover and simmer 20 minutes or until squash is very tender. Process squash mixture, in small batches, in food processor until smooth. return soup to saucepan; add remaining can of broth, nutmeg and pepper. simmer, uncovered, 5 minutes stirring occasionally.

SCALLOPED POTATO-ONION BAKE -



1 can Cream of Celery Soup
Dash of pepper
1 small onion, thinly sliced
Paprika

— serves 6 —
1/2 c. milk
4 medium potatoes, thinly sliced
1tbsp margarine or butter
Shredded cheddar cheese

Mix soup, milk and pepper. In 1 1/2 quart casserole layer half of potatoes and onion and soup mixture. Repeat layers. Dot with margarine. Sprinkle with paprika. Cover and bake at 400 degrees for 1 hour. Uncover, sprinkle cheddar cheese over the top and bake 15 minutes more or until potatoes are tender and the cheese is melted.

GOLDEN MUSHROOM PORK & APPLES



— Serves 4 —

1 can of condensed golden mushroom soup (or 1/4 c. water	just plain mushroom)
1/2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce	1/2 tbsp. of brown sugar
2 large Granny Smith apples, sliced (about 2 cups)	1/2 tbsp. dried thyme leaves, crushed
4 boneless pork chops, 3/4 inch thick	1 large onion, sliced (about 1 cup)

SLOW COOKER DIRECTIONS

In a slow cooker mix soup, water, brown sugar, Worcestershire and thyme. Add apples, onions, and pork.

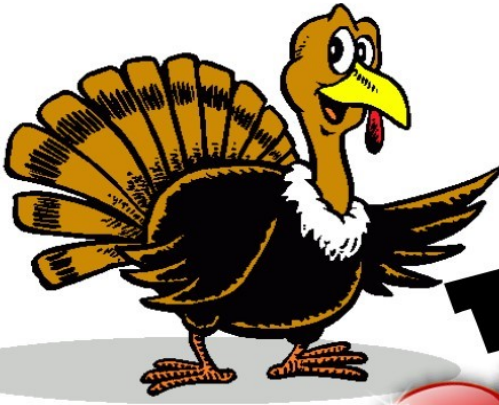

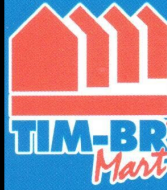
