## LESLIE'S HEALTHY EATING CORNER

### **Breakfast - HAM, EGG & CHEESE ROLL-UPS** - Serves 2-3

5 eggs	1 tsp garlic powder
Kosher salt	Ground Black Pepper
1 tbsp. butter	3/4 cup shredded cheddar
1/2 cup baby spinach	1/2 cup chopped tomatoes
10 slices ham	

Heat broiler. In a large bowl, crack eggs. Whisk together with garlic powder and season with salt and pepper. In a large nonstick skillet over medium heat, melt butter. Add eggs and scramble, stirring occasionally, 3 minutes. Stir in cheddar until melted, then stir in baby spinach and tomatoes until combined. On a cutting board, place two slices of ham. Top with a big spoonful of scrambled eggs and roll up. Repeat with remaining ham and scrambled eggs. Place roll-ups in a shallow baking dish and broil until ham is crispy, 5 minutes.

### **Lunch - BLT MACARONI SALAD** - Serves 6

1/2 cup mayonnaise	3 tablespoons chili sauce
2 tablespoons lemon juice	1 teaspoon sugar
3 cups cooked elbow macaroni	1/2 cup chopped seeded tomato
2 tbsp chopped green onion	3 cups shredded lettuce
4 slices of cooked and crumbled bacon	

In a large bowl, combine the first four ingredients. Add the macaroni, tomatoes, and onions; toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate. Just before serving, add lettuce and bacon; toss to coat.

### **Supper - CHICKEN PARMESAN STUFFED ZUCCHINI** - Serves 4

kosher salt	2 cloves garlic, minced
1.5 cups marinara sauce	
2 1/2 cups shredded mozzarella, divided	
1 cup freshly grated Parmesan, divided, plus more for garnish	
12 oz. fresh or frozen breaded chicken, cooked according to pkg instructions and diced	
Freshly ground black pepper	
6 zucchini, halved, seeds scooped out with a spoon	
1 tbsp, chopped parsley	

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a large bowl, combine 2 cups mozzarella, 1/2 cup Parmesan, garlic, marinara sauce and chicken. Season with salt and pepper then gently stir until all ingredients are combined. Using a spoon, scoop this mixture into your zucchini boats. top the boats with remaining mozzarella and Parmesan and bake until the zucchinis are tender, about 25 minutes. Garnish with parsley and more Parmesan.

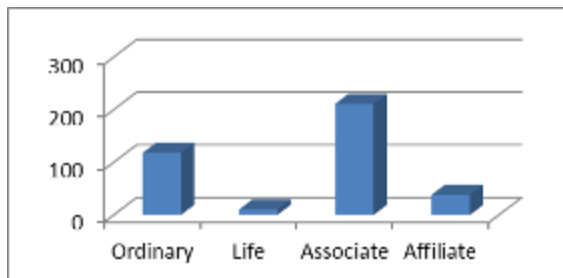
