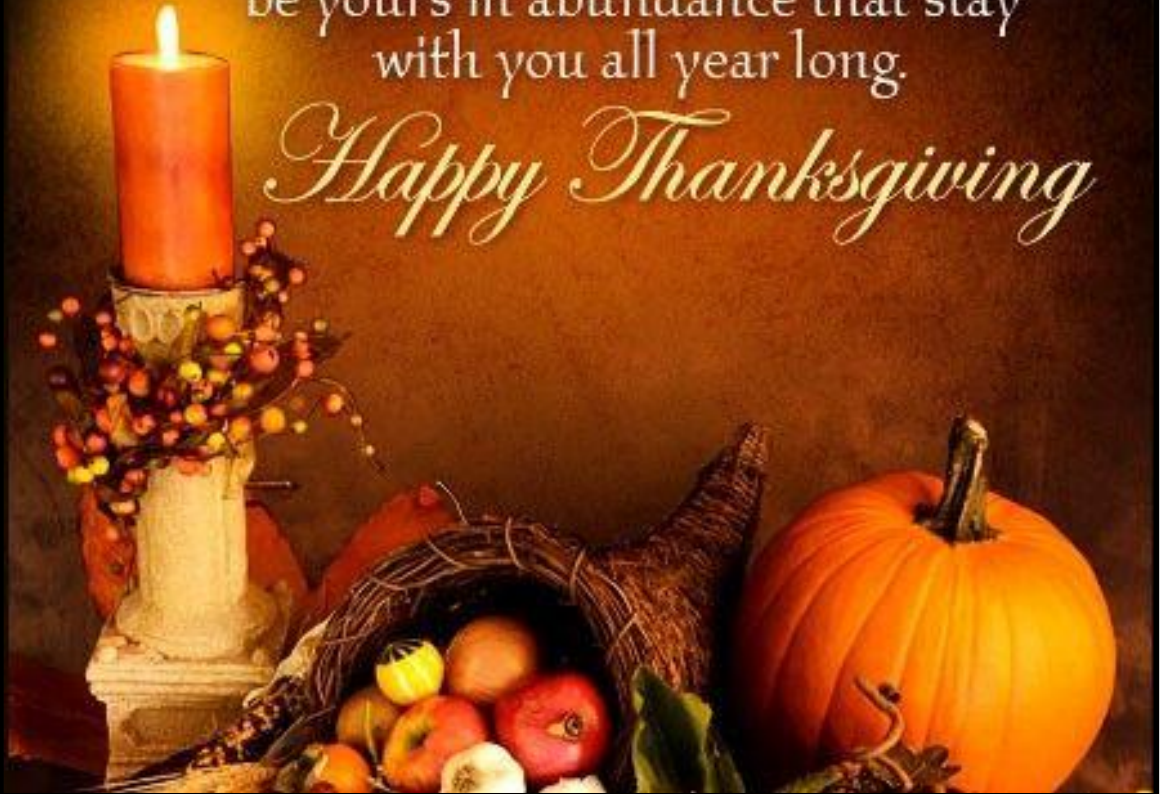

LESLIE'S HEALTHY EATING CORNER

I remember when i was a little girl the many times that mom would open a can of soup to mix with her recipes. Fall is here so October will have warm recipes made with soup. ENJOY!

WILD RICE WITH DRIED APRICOTS AND CRANBERRIES - Serves 6-8

1/2 c. uncooked wild rice	3 c. chicken broth, divided
1 c. apple juice	3/4 c. uncooked long-grain white rice
1/2 c. golden raisins	1/2 c. chopped dried apricots
1/2 c. dried cranberries	2 tbsp. butter
3/4 c. chopped onion	1/2 c. coarsely chopped pecans
1/3 c. chopped fresh parsley	

Rinse wild rice in a fine strainer under cold running water. drain. Combine wild rice, 1 1/2 cups chicken broth and apple juice in 2 quart saucepan. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Reduce heat to low; simmer, covered about 45 minutes or until rice is tender. Drain.

Meanwhile, combine white rice and remaining 1 1/2 cups broth in separate 2 quart saucepan. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. reduce heat to low; simmer, covered, 12 to 15 minutes. Stir raisins, apricots and cranberries into white rice; simmer 5 minutes or until rice is tender and fluffy and liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat. Let stand covered 5 minutes or until fruit is tender; set aside. Melt butter in large skillet over medium heat. add onion; cook and stir 5 to 6 minutes until tender. Stir in pecans. Cook and stir 2 minutes. Add wild rice and white rice mixtures to skillet. Stir in parsley; cook and stir over medium heat about 2 minutes or until heated through.



CHICKEN BROCCOLI DIVAN - Serves 4

1 lb. fresh broccoli, cut into spears, cooked and drained	1/3 c. of milk
1/2 c. of shredded cheese	2 tbsp dry bread crumbs
1 tbsp margarine or butter, melted	
1/2 c. cubed, cooked chicken or turkey	1 can of Condensed Broccoli Cheese Soup or Cream of chicken Soup

In a 9 inch pie plate or 2 quart shallow baking dish arrange broccoli and chicken. In a small bowl mix soup and milk and pour over the broccoli and chicken. Sprinkle cheese over soup mixture. Mix bread crumbs with margarine and sprinkle over cheese. Bake at 400 degrees for 25 minutes or until hot. November another cool month preparing for our festive month which is just around the corner. Enjoy some more warm recipes from the heart.



3 BEAN SALAD WITH SWEET AND SOUR APRICOT DRESSING - Serves 6

1/2 c. apricot jam	1/4 c. red wine vinegar
1 tsp celery seeds	1 (16 oz.) can of kidney beans rinsed and drained
1 small red onion, thinly sliced	Salt and Pepper to taste
1/4 lb. cooked fresh or frozen green beans cut into 2 inch pieces	
1/4 lb. cooked fresh or frozen yellow beans cut into 2 inch pieces.	

Combine preserves, vinegar and celery seeds in medium salad bowl; stir until well blended. Add kidney beans, green and yellow beans, and onion. Toss well to blend. Season with salt and freshly ground pepper to taste.
